



## NOTICE

Ohsweken (June 15, 2016) – Six Nations Elected Council, Public Works, and First Nations Engineering Services Ltd. would like to remind the community that as construction for the two major infrastructure upgrades in Ohsweken progress, there will be periods of disruption to the water distribution system.

To coordinate the temporary closure of driveways and water shut-offs for these upgrades, First Nations Engineering Services Ltd. will be visiting each of the affected businesses and residents to provide notice and details of the expected disruption.

In the upcoming week, in addition to one lane traffic, traffic delays, noise, dust, and periods of service disruption to the water distribution system, community members can expect to see the installation of a temporary all-way stop at the intersection of Chiefswood Road and Fourth Line.

Community members are asked to:

- Reduce speeds when traveling in designated construction zones
- Be mindful of pedestrians, workers, and machinery
- Obey all road signs
- Always come to a complete stop at all posted stop signs

The anticipated completion date for the Ohsweken Infrastructure Upgrades Project, which includes replacement of undersized, worn sections of the watermain and widening of Chiefswood Road for implementation of a left-hand turning lane, is October 2016. Updates will continue to be provided as the project progresses.
