Six Nations of the Grand River
Village Infrastructure Project

The following is an update from Community Notice No.4, updating local residents and businesses of the presently ongoing watermain and road construction project.

The watermain construction along Chiefswood Road and Forth Line Road has been completed. The new watermain is presently online and delivering potable water to community members and businesses.

For the remainder of this week, Sierra Infrastructure Inc. will be installing road crossing culverts along Chiefswood Road and Forth Line Road. On July 28th, Sierra will be working on Chiefswood Road out front of the Village Plaza replacing two (2) road crossing culverts. Sunrise Court will be temporarily blocked off, but access can be obtained via. Cao Lane. On July 29th, Sierra will working at the intersection of Forth Line Road and Woodland Drive replacing one (1) road crossing culvert. Please try and avoid these areas if possible.

For next week (August 02-05, 2016), Sierra Infrastructure Inc. will concentrate their forces in the down town area continuing with the full road reconstruction and roadway widening.

Construction Zone Reminders

During culvert replacements and road construction, the roadway may be limited to one (1) lane. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers, so please be patient. Please reduce speeds throughout the construction zones. This is a safety concern for everyone.

We understand there will be many inconveniences and delays while the work is underway and everyone involved has taken all the necessary precautions and planning in order to maintain the smoothest transition as possible.
