SIX NATIONS POLICE ASSISTING OPP IN TRIPLE HOMICIDE INVESTIGATION

Six Nations Police are currently assisting the OPP in a triple homicide investigation in which three Six Nations community members were found deceased in an area in the Municipality of Middlesex Centre, near the Oneida First Nation Territory.

“We are saddened to hear of the loss of three of our community members. Our thoughts now are with the family members and our community agencies are gathering together to provide support to the families and the community. Community agencies are providing support tonight at Gane Yohs Community Health Center located at 1769 Chiefswood Road, Ohsweken, for anyone who is in need of additional supports. They will also be available on Friday and throughout the weekend. We understand that this is an on-going police investigation by the OPP and we encourage them to conduct as thorough an investigation as possible to find the people responsible for this terrible crime. We also ask that the families be granted the privacy that is needed at this time of grief”. Chief G. Ava Hill

Police have confirmed the identities of the deceased as:

- Melissa Trudy MILLER, 37-year-old, female of Six Nations of the Grand River.
- Alan Grant PORTER, 33-year-old, male of Six Nations of the Grand River.
- Michael Shane JAMIESON, 32-year-old, male of Six Nations of the Grand River.

Police are asking for the public's assistance with regard to this investigation.
