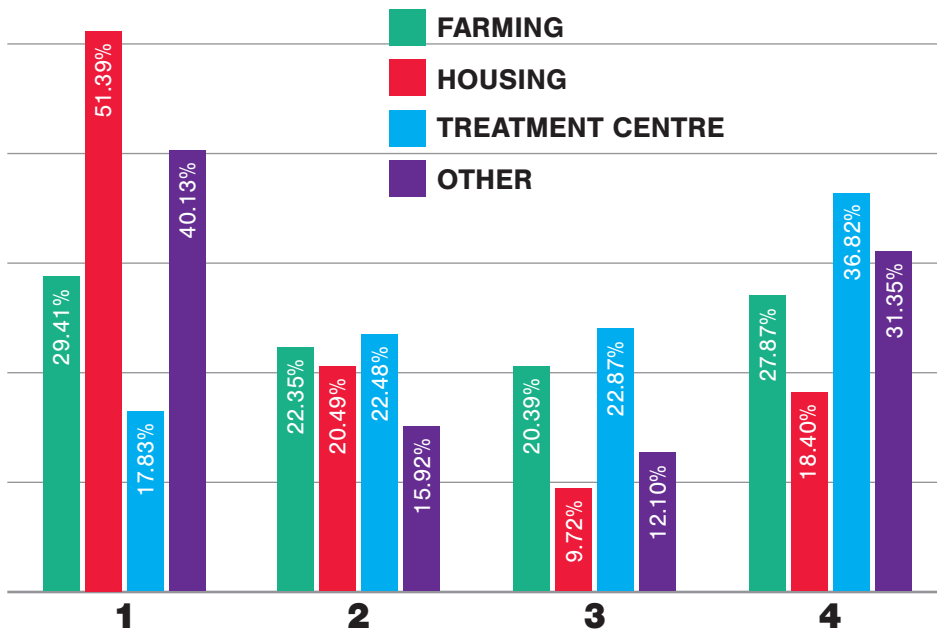


# COMMUNITY OUTREACH SURVEY RESULTS

Recently Six Nations Elected Council conducted a Community Outreach Survey. The purpose of the survey was to give Six Nations community members the opportunity to get involved and provide their input/feedback on the preferred use of the Burtch lands and some other community needs. See results below.

## QUESTION 1

What do you feel is the best option for future use of the Burtch lands? Please rank the following options where 1 = most important and 4 = least important.

## CONCLUSION

In conclusion 204 surveys were submitted online and 135 hard copies were received, for a total of 339 surveys received. Based on the surveys submitted and priority ranking, there is an overwhelming response from the community of Six Nations to use the Burtch lands for housing.
