## Behaviour Consultant Services

The Behaviour Consultant is a short-term service option offered through Six Nations of the Grand River Child and Family Services: Clinical Services Unit.

Behaviour Consultant services have been established to address the need for intervention regarding challenging behaviours displayed by children and youth ages 2 -18 within the Six Nations community who have no identified developmental diagnosis.

The Behaviour Consultant looks to improve the ability of family, to manage and address challenging behaviours through the use of specific intervention and management skills formulated on an individual "client need" basis.

Family will be closely involved in a collaborative effort from determining appropriate behaviour plans to the management of the client's environment and the consequences that maintain behaviours. Family is also important in providing and collecting the information used to assess behaviour plan effectiveness.

## Intervention and Behavioural Plans

Behaviour Plans are created based on client need in one of the following categories:

- In home and school
- In home (Individual or sibling)
- In school



Intervention consists of behaviour identification, behavioural assessment, formulation and collaborative development of behavioural plans to be utilized in the client's environment by the client and family members.

Direct and indirect methods of observation and information collection help in the process of behaviour plan creation and monitoring. The information; collected by the Behaviour Consultant, client and family members; is used to assess effectiveness and adjust the strategy to address challenging behaviour.

Involvement of the Behaviour Consultant is on a short-term basis.

For some cases, Behaviour Consultant services may be enhanced through the involvement of an individual counsellor to assist the family and/or client with other difficulties being experienced.

## Access to Services

Referrals to Behavioural Consultant services are forwarded to Service Coordination Unit at Six Nations Child and Family Services.

Referral forms require the signed consent of the child's legal caregiver.

Service Coordination Unit, Six Nations Child and Family Services Intake Unit will assist the family in setting up appropriate services.

\* through necessity the Behaviour Consultant, Clinical Services Unit, may be required to provide service based on priority in regards to need of service and wait list.
